Discussion and Agreement

- *Technical Implementation Report*

- Shared by Dr. Frederic Gay and emphasized how the projects are rated

- *Schedule of Activities of LIFE*

- Meetings and Trainings/workshops
 - Possibility of a colloquium with other health projects of ERASMUS in the region on Sept/October 2020 back to back with the participation of LIFE for SEA Ed at the ICTMM meeting in BKK.

Agreement:

- **Dr Frederic Gay will discuss this suggestion with ERASMUS**
- **Participation of LIFE in the coming ICTMM will either be in the form of an oral or poster presentation, and not a booth or parallel session.**

- Evaluation from Trainees – preliminary results of the evaluation identified the presence of experts from other countries and the inclusion of new topics as the strengths of the training/workshop

- ***Financial Situation:***

- Updating re the transfer of funds (Common Funds) to be loaned to PSU. Until the meeting time- SEAMEO's bank has not received anything yet
- No release yet of funds for equipment and the second tranche of budget funds

- Deans of the partners' institutions (Thai, Slovenia and Portugal) to write another letter address to the President of Sorbonne University related to this issue. Dr. Vladimir to draft a letter and also use the email of SEAMEO as working paper, since we are highlighting the same issue

- The contents of the LIFE PROJECT included in the SEAMEO Website were shown to the group.
- Dr. Frederic gay shared the progress of the development of the LIFE website

- ***Collaterals (Brochures, leaflets, etc.)***

- SEAMEO TROP MED Network has sent two prototype of the brochures for LIFE project April for comments of SU. No comments yet
- SEAMEO has volunteered to have these brochures printed in BKK provided funds will be sent for this purposes.
